

Virginia & Frank Kunath Family Scholarship Fund

The Virginia & Frank Kunath Family Scholarship Fund is being created in celebration of the life and faith of Virginia and Frank Kunath, past parishioners of Erie St. Joseph Catholic Church. The scholarship fund is being established by their daughter, Janet L. (Kunath) Cunningham-Bly, and son-in-law, John P. Bly. The mission of the scholarship fund is to support young adults in their college or technical training education.

The student eligibility requirements of the scholarship fund are as follows:

1. U.S. citizen
2. Active in St. Joseph Catholic Church, Erie, MI
3. High school senior graduating in Spring, 2020
4. Accepted as a full time student at an accredited college or university (associate or bachelor degree) or vocational or trade school in Summer/Fall, 2020
5. A completed scholarship application form must be submitted to the rectory office

The scholarship application / review process / selection / award 2020 timeline is shown below:

- a. Eligible students may pick up the scholarship application forms March 2 – 6 from Shannon Tunison, in the rectory office.
- b. The completed scholarship application forms must be returned by March 27 to Shannon.
- c. The St. Joseph Catholic Church Endowment Foundation Committee will review the applications and submit their chosen candidate(s) to Janet Cunningham-Bly by April 15 for her approval. Once approved, the selected candidate(s) will be informed of their scholarship award by May 7.

Notes:

- The scholarship is an annual award.
- The scholarship award amount is dependent on the number of selected candidates.
- The scholarship award will be paid directly to the school(s) on behalf of the selected student(s).
- The scholarship is for a student in his/her first year of study at a college, university, vocation, or trade school.
- The scholarship award may be extended beyond the first year of study based on meeting a 2.5 GPA freshman year or 3.0 GPA for subsequent years.
